A message from our current Grand Knight

To all our past and present Knights of Columbus, let me congratulate you and thank you and honor you for your time and efforts put into making the 40-year mark for the Light of Christ Council 8726.

For those that came before our current members, they laid the groundwork to support our Parish, School and Community. The current members have continued that work growing the council and building upon the 4 principles of Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism.

I am very proud to serve and lead an exemplary group of men and this great organization.

History of the Council

In January 1983 there wree only three Knights of Columbus councils serving the vast Berks County community. Michael D. O'reilly, who was at the time General Agent for Knights of Columbus Insurance, approached his Pastor, Rev. J. Pascal of St. Ignatius Loyola Parish, Singking Spring, PA with a proposition to form a new Knights of Columbus Council that would server the parish. O'Reilly also approached Father William J. Nessel of St. Francis de Sales parish in Robesonia for the same purpose, Both Father Pascal and Father Nessel were agreeable and O'Reilly turned to District Deputy John L. Schum to proceed with the paperwork, and preparations were made to contact the parishioners of both parishes. At that point, the process hit a snag; apparently there were members of the three councils who objected to new councils being established in Berks County due to competition. A complaint was issued to then State Deputy Basil Desiderio who referred the complaint to Henry J. Mullen, State Membership Director for investigation. The allegation of too many councils turned out to have no merit and the process of obtaining new member continue very slowly.

Then, two things happened to hasten the development. On August 15, 1983, St. Ignatius Loyola Parish got a new Pastor, Rev. Msgr. James A. Treston. Shortly after that, on October 1, 1983, Henry J. Mullen, who had been following the progress in the area, was transferred from Pittsburgh to Sinking Spring and became a member of St. Ignatius Loyala Parish. Mullen contacted John Schum and Mike O'Reilly and called an organizational meeting of all who had expressed interest in the new councils. There were fourteen from St. Ignatius and four from St. Fracis de Sales. Thirty is the number required by the Knights of Columbus to form a new council. It was decided to combine the applications from both parishes and go from there. A second organizational meeting was held in February 1984. After a lesson on what the Knights of Columbus is about, many of the attendees took membership applications in order to recruit new members, and it was agreed that Mr. Mullen would send letters to members who belonged to councils outside the state but lived in Berks County.

At that meeting it was evident that several of the men interested in the council were skilled leaders from other councils. We wer able to form a slate of probably leaders for the new council. One member in particular, John Sadowski, stood out and was able to recruit several more members. In April 1984 we had secured enough applications to proceed with a First Degree Exemplification which was performed by members of Council 793 and 7179. In May 1984 after securing the required 30 members, we submitted the applications to the Knights of Columbus Supreme headquarters in New Haven, Connecticut, and on June 3, 184 we received the Council number of 8726 and officially became a Council of the Knights of Columbus. John Sadowski was elected Grand Knight of the new council and Henry Mullen was appointed District Deputy of the Berks County # 20 councils. At a later date, we chose our name and received our Charter. During the first years of the council, meetings were held on the 2nd and 3rd Monday of each month. The first meeting of the month was held at Saint Ignatius Loyola Rectory basement, and second meeting of the month was held in St. Francis de Sales Rectory basement. At the time, St. Francis de Sales parish did not have a building to celbrate Mass so the parish's Masses were held at Trinity Lutheran Church in Robesonia. Our first Installation of Officers ceremony was held after Saturday night Mass in that facility. After our first year we obtained a Star Council Award in recognition of our recruiting and programming efforts.

More recently, our council has initiated a number of projects including hosting the Vatican International Eucharistic Miracles Exhibition during a July weekend in 2023 in our School Gymnasium. With the leadership of former Grand Knight Fred Henrich, we had over 300 people visit the exhibition comprised of 152 posters highlighting the miracles and the tests performed to validate them. And during Covid, former Grand Knight Dan Wozniak came up with the idea of hosting an annual Golf Tournament (this year being our 5th year) with all proceeds going to the St. Ignatius School's Scholarship program, John Paul II Center, Mary's Shelter and Opportunity House. We have raised over \$55,000 dollars in the first 4 years and this year's event will be just as good in early September 2024. And the council continues with many other programs to server our Parish, School and Community, some that were started back in the early days of the council.
