


This is the starting screen (Home Page) after the terminal starts up.

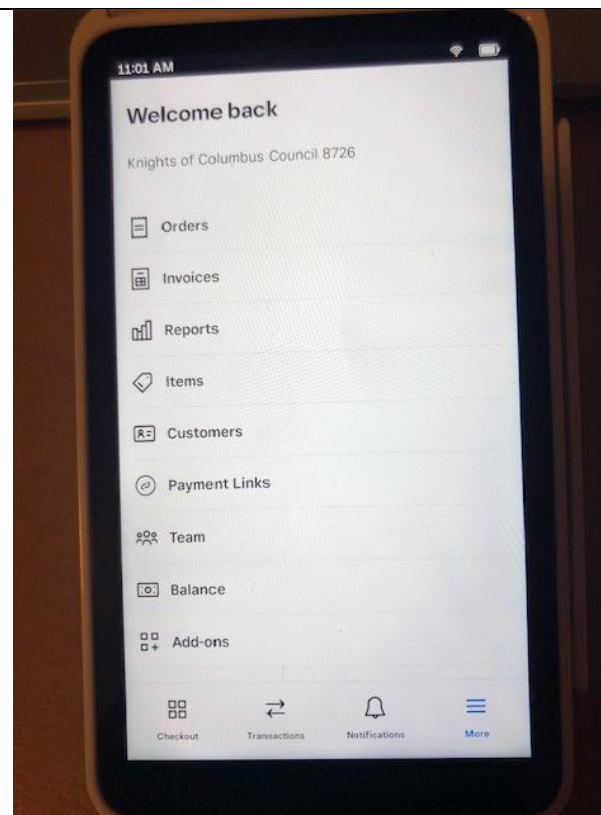
If you see the Wifi symbol  in the upper right corner next to the battery indicator, you're good to go.

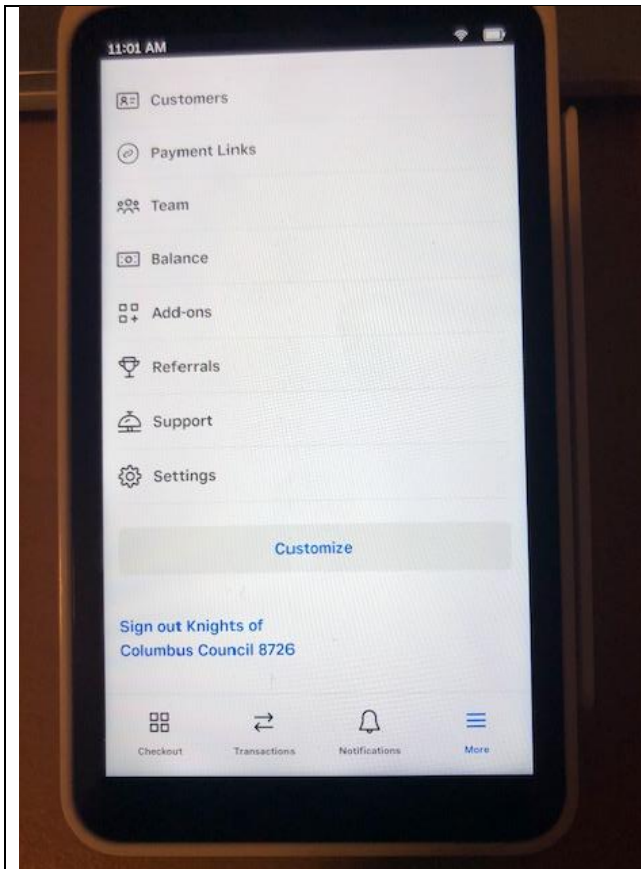
If you do not see the Wifi symbol, you will have to tell the terminal which network to use.

To do that, click on the More button at the lower right.

You will see the Welcome back screen with a whole list of options. The option you'll need is at the bottom of the list but you'll have to scroll down to get to it.

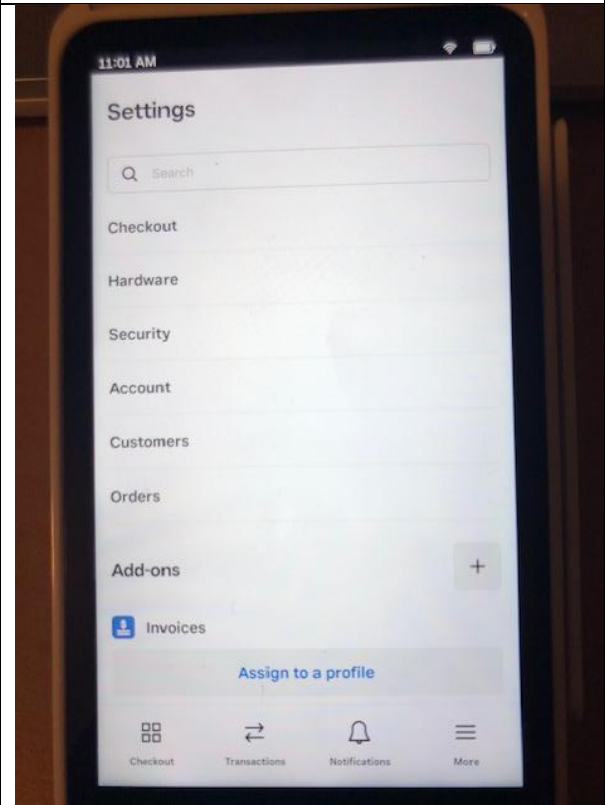
Swipe the screen upward with your finger to get to the bottom portion of the list.

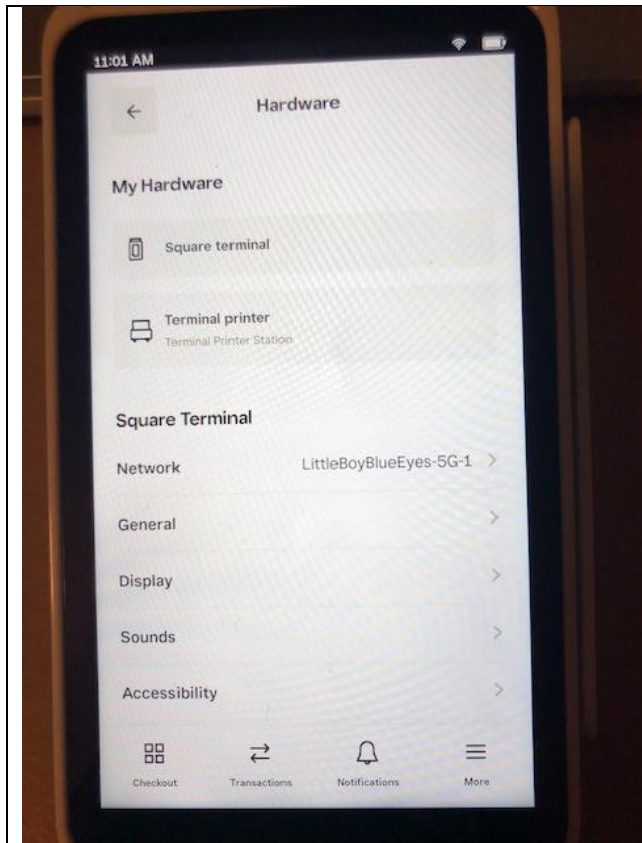




On the bottom portion of the list select Settings.

On the Settings screen, select Hardware.





Under Hardware, look for Square Terminal and under that you'll see Network.

In this example, the Wifi symbol did appear so the Terminal is on line.

The Network being used is LittleBoyBlueEyes (that's my home network).

To select the appropriate network, click on Network.

On the Network screen you'll have to review the list.

You may have to select your home network, the church network, or the school network.

The Church and School network passwords are stored in the terminal.

After selecting the appropriate network, the system will connect, the Wifi symbol will appear and you should be good to go.
